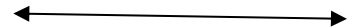
Introduction of the lesson: The instructor introduced the lesson in an interesting and effective manner, and the purpose (goal) of the lesson was clear.



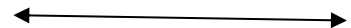
Organization: The instructor developed the content in an organized manner, emphasizing important points with examples and/or illustrations.



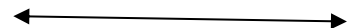

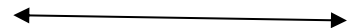
Use of active learning: The learning activity had an appropriate place in the lesson and its purpose was clear.



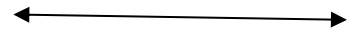
Summary of the lesson: The instructor brought the lesson to a logical conclusion and summarized key points.
